

The Internship programme of the Centre for European Studies

The Centre for European Studies is the official think-tank of the European People's Party; the largest transnational party of Europe, offers at its Secretariat in Brussels internships of three to six months for university graduates of Europe.

The Centre is a new and evolving organisation. Therefore, the traineeship gives a unique opportunity for the trainees to test their capacities and to see their ideas have a real impact. The internship is focused on immersing the successful candidates with the short - term and long-term policy research and other activities of the Centre: organizing meetings and conferences, preparing reports and analysis, editing publications including the 'European View', updating the website and databases, communicating with member foundations, co-operating with the European People's Party in policy research and other activities, liaising with officials from the European institutions, etc.

Criteria:

To apply for the internship programme, you must fulfill the following criteria:

- You must hold a university degree. Additional educational qualifications are welcome
- You must be fluent in English, also in writing. Adequate knowledge of one or two more languages is considered an asset
- Computer literacy and internet experience
- Additional experience in policy research considered an asset
- Good knowledge of European politics

Remuneration:

Remuneration for interns is comparable to the internship programmes offered at the European institutions.
